

ORDINANCE 2640

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PLACEMENT AND OPERATION OF VENDING MACHINES IN THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the issue of the placement and operation of vending machines at private residences has come before the Council of the Village of Dennison for consideration, due to resident complaints; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Dennison finds it necessary to regulate the placement and operation of vending machines in the Village.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Vending machines may not be openly placed upon the outside areas of a property that contains a residential structure(s).

SECTION 2. Such prohibition applies to vending machines being used for either personal use or commercial use.

SECTION 3. "Vending machine" is generally defined as any coin/cash-operated or credit/debit card-operated machine for the vending of items such as beverages, tobacco products or food products.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance applies to properties located within the territorial limits of the Village of Dennison, Ohio, and no such property shall be granted "grandfather" status from the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. A person violating this Ordinance, on the first violation, shall be assessed a fine of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00).

SECTION 6. Each subsequent violation of this Ordinance shall result in a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall become effective at the first time permitted by Ohio law.
