

ORDINANCE NO. 2519

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE REGIONAL INCOME TAX AGENCY FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE INCOME TAX LAWS OF THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON, OHIO, AND FOR THE COLLECTION OF SAID TAXES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Dennison, Ohio desires to contract with an outside agency to administer the income tax laws of the Village and to act as its agent in the collection of said taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Village is in receipt of a proposal from the Regional Income Tax Agency for the administration of these services; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Dennison, Ohio desires to authorize the Mayor of the Village of Dennison, Ohio to enter into an agreement with the Regional Income Tax Agency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON, STATE OF OHIO;

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is hereby directed and authorized to enter into an agreement with the Regional Income Tax Agency to have said agency act as the Village's agent in administering the income tax laws of the Village of Dennison, Ohio, and to collect said income taxes (a copy of such agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten).

**SECTION 2.** That this Ordinance shall supercede all previously adopted Ordinances or Resolutions or Motions in direct conflict herewith.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is hereby deemed to be an emergency to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Dennison, Ohio and shall go into full force and effect on the first day after its passage by the Village Council as an emergency measure provided it receives the necessary votes.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
