

ORDINANCE NO. 2579

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH KIMBLE RECYCLING AND
DISPOSAL, INC. FOR REFUSE COLLECTION, DISPOSAL, AND CURBSIDE
RECYCLING BILLING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Dennison, Ohio has passed and adopted an ordinance for contracting with Kimble Recycling and Disposal, Inc. for garbage disposal and curbside recycling for residential customers located in the Village of Dennison, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Dennison, Ohio has authorized the Mayor of the Village of Dennison, Ohio to enter into a contract with Kimble Recycling and Disposal, Inc. for refuse collection, disposal and curbside recycling; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Dennison, Ohio wishes to use the services of the Kimble Company to perform billing operations on behalf of the Village of Dennison, Ohio in relation to billing residential customers for garbage disposal and recycling services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Kimble Recycling and Disposal, Inc. for billing residents for refuse collection and disposal and curbside recycling services, and that the Village of Dennison, Ohio shall be responsible for payment for services to Kimble Recycling and Disposal, Inc. directly.

SECTION 2. A copy of such billing contract is attached hereto, and any contract entered into by the Mayor will substantially comply with the terms contained in such billing contract as attached hereto.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Dennison, Ohio, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to enter into contract for the service necessary in a timely manner, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
