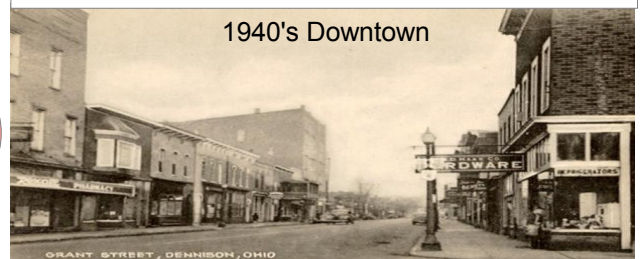
## THE SHERMAN STREET PROJECT
