

ORDINANCE NO. 1585

REGULATING TRUCK ROUTES IN THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO STAY UPON TRUCK ROUTES BY CERTAIN VEHICLES.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Dennison, Ohio;

Section 1. That no truck shall travel upon village streets except where the same is marked, "Truck Route", except for local deliveries.

Section 2. The Village Administrator shall set out the "Truck Route" in the said Village by and with the consent of Council; he shall further make appropriate signs designating the said, "Truck "Route", and install same.

Section 3. Any person who violates Section 1 of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00 and costs.

Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and property of the inhabitants of the Village of Dennison, in that the village property needs to be protected, and shall therefore be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
