

ORDINANCE NO. 1686
TO LEVY INCOME TAXES UNIFORMLY AS PASSED BY
ELECTORATE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1977

Whereas the Village of Dennison residents voted June 7, 1977, to levy a tax on income at a rate in excess of one per cent (1%) to wit: one half percent; and

Whereas it is necessary to set the levy's effective date to meet the recommendations of the Clerk and Income Tax Clerk:

Now therefore, be it hereby ordained by the Village council of Dennison, Ohio that

1. The tax on income at the rate of one half of one percent shall be levied effective July 1, 1977 and thereafter.
2. The Clerk is directed to act accordingly.
3. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village, the reason is to have a uniform levy of taxes permitting due arrangements to be made to collect the same after July 1, 1977, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage.
