

ORDINANCE NO. 1762

To require the posting of a bond upon the digging up a Street, Alley, or sidewalk within the corporation limits of the Village of Dennison, Ohio.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Dennison, that:

1. No person, firm, corporation or utility shall dig up the Street, alley, or sidewalk without first having posted a bond in the sum of \$2,000.00 on each location where the street, alley or sidewalk surfaces are being dug up, with the Mayor, said bond shall be conditioned that the posting of the bond is to insure the proper closing of the opening and the returning of the street, alley or sidewalk surface to what it was before the opening with like material of said surface.
2. The Village Administrator shall inspect the said street, alley or sidewalk project and report to the Mayor that the same is satisfactory whereupon the bond is released, or in the alternative, report to the Mayor that the project is not satisfactory and the bond is not to be released and the Mayor is to turn the collection of the bond over to the Village Solicitor.
3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and for the further reason being that the free flow of traffic and the safety of the residents of the Village Streets, Alleys and Sidewalks and to eliminate existing hazards to pedestrians and vehicles; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
