

**ORDINANCE NO. 1852**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING GARAGE, YARD, BASEMENT AND PERSONAL RESIDENCE SALES  
IN THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON, OHIO**

**WHEREAS, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE  
VILLAGE OF DENNISON, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** This ordinance shall apply to all sales of personal property conducted from a garage, yard, basement or personal residence, but shall not apply to business sales or to auction sales conducted by licensed auctioneers.

**SECTION 2.** Any individual or partnership conducting a sale as defined herein and offering personal property for sale to the general public within the Village of Dennison, Ohio, shall first obtain a permit for the sale from the Clerk of the Village of Dennison, Ohio and shall pay the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) for said permit.

**SECTION 3.** The permit shall entitle the purchaser of said permit to conduct a yard sale, basement sale, garage sale, or sale of merchandise of goods from a personal residence for a period of time not to exceed four (4) days and the four (4) days shall be specified on the permit. Only one four (4) day permit shall be issued to the same purchaser or family or for the same location within a forty-five day (45) period.

**SECTION 4.** No sign advertising a home sale may be displayed at any place except on the premises of which the sale is held or on other private premises with the permission of the landowner. It shall be a violation of this ordinance to place signs on any telephone poles, light poles or other public building structures.

**SECTION 5.** After the expiration of the time provided for on the four (4) day permit, all merchandise and personal property shall then be placed inside and not within the view of the general public.

**SECTION 6.** Anyone conducting a sale as described herein without a permit or anyone conducting a sale for a time period that is not included within the permit shall be guilty of violating this ordinance.

**SECTION 7.** A violation of this ordinance shall be punishable as a minor misdemeanor. For a first offense, a maximum fine of up to One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) plus costs.

**SECTION 8.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after the earliest period allowed by law.
