ORDINANCE NO. 1874

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THAT THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON'S SAFETY FORCES BE TRAINED AND PASS A COURSE OF INSTRUCTION IN CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR), PROVIDING FOR A TRAINING CLASS AND REQUIRING THE TRAINING TO BE COMPLETED BY JUNE OF 1988 FOR MEMBERS OF THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Village of Dennison, Ohio, has an interest in having its safety employees complete a course of instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Dennison, Ohio.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Village of Dennison to mandate that the Village's safety forces including police, fire, and its department heads complete and pass a course of instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the legislative authority of the Village of Dennison, State of Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. That all employees of the Village of Dennison's fire department and police department shall complete an approved course of instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) by June 1, 1988.

SECTION 2. That the Village of Dennison will conduct cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) classes for the benefit of its safety employees, and any other employee of the Village who desires to complete CPR training.

SECTION 3. That the Village employee required to take CPR training may complete a course of instruction from any other approved instructor at their expense provided it is completed by June 1, 1988 in the event of a conflict in the scheduling of the Village of Dennison CPR classes.
