

ORDINANCE NO. 2167

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2052 ZONING CODE FOR THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON, REGARDING THE REGULATION OF SWIMMING POOLS WITHIN THE VILLAGE AND FOR THE GENERAL WELFARE OF THE COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Dennison has determined that it is in the interest of the community and for reasons of safety and welfare of its residents that a modification of the Village Zoning Code relative to the regulation of swimming pools is necessary,

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Dennison as follows:

SECTION 1: Sections 515.6 and 615.6 concerning the regulation of private swimming pools shall be modified to define the following terms as provided herein:

Private Swimming Pool: Any structure that contains water over 24 inches in depth and which is used, or intended to be used, for swimming or recreational bathing in connection with an occupancy and which is available only to the family and guests of the house holder. This includes inground, above ground, and on-ground swimming pools, hot tubs and spas.

Water Treatment: Circulation equipment for private swimming pools shall be of adequate size to turn over the entire pool water content at least once every 12 hours. The system shall be designed to provide proper turnover rate based upon the manufacturer's recommended maximum flow rate of the filter in clean media condition. All recirculating systems shall be provided with a hair and lint strainer installed in the system ahead of the pump.

Drainage Systems: The swimming pool and equipment shall be equipped to be emptied completely of water and the discharged water shall be disposed of in an approved manner that will not create a nuisance to adjoining property.

SECTION 2: This modification shall have no effect on any other provision of the Village of Dennison Zoning Code that is not otherwise inconsistent herewith.
