

ORDINANCE NO. 2269

AN ORDINANCE TO OPEN A RECENTLY CONSTRUCTED STREET WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON FOR PUBLIC USE AND ESTABLISHING A NAME IN REFERENCE TO IT

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Dennison has recently constructed an Industrial Park within the Village and has additionally constructed a street that circles through the area of the Park. The Council for the Village of Dennison has determined that the interests of the Village are served by opening the newly constructed street to public use and to establish a name for the street by which it may be identified and referenced. This action is necessary to properly provide access to the area of the Industrial Park as well as to provide postal and emergency services to that area of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Dennison as follows:

SECTION 1: That the street that circles the area of the Dennison Industrial Park, as identified further by the maps attached hereto as Exhibit A and B, shall hereafter be open for public use.

SECTION 2: That the said street referenced in Section 1 above shall be named Dennison Yard Circle for all legal purposes including, but not limited to postal, police, fire and emergency services.

SECTION 3: That the Clerk of the Village of Dennison shall cause this Ordinance to be delivered to the Tuscarawas County Recorder, the U.S. Postal Authority that services the Village, the Dennison Police Department, the Dennison Fire Department, the 911 Emergency Center, the Tuscarawas County Sheriff and any other agency as the Council shall direct. Further, a copy of this Ordinance shall be posted for a period of not less than thirty (30) days at the Dennison Municipal Building.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure by Council as it provides for the health, safety and welfare of the community and, as such, shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
