ORDINANCE NO. 2406

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE REMOVAL OF FIRE DAMAGED STRUCTURES IN THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Dennison has determined that it is necessary to pass an Ordinance regulating the removal of fire damaged structures in the Village of Dennison;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON, STATE OF OHIO;

- **SECTION 1.** The Village of Dennison hereby authorizes the procedure prescribed in Ohio Revised Code 3929.86 to be implemented in said Village. Therefore, no insurance company doing business in this state shall pay a claim to a named insured for fire damage to a structure located within the Village of Dennison, unless the applicable provisions and requirements of Ohio Revised Code 3929.86 are fulfilled.
- **SECTION 2.** The Fire Chief of the Village of Dennison is hereby designated as the officer of the Village authorized to carry out the duties prescribed in Ohio Revised Code 3929.86. The Fire Chief shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the State Superintendent of Insurance.
- **SECTION 3.** The Fire Chief shall cause all fire-damaged structures located within the Village of Dennison to be inspected and provide for the removal and/or repair of insecure, unsafe or structurally defective fire damaged structures and buildings pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 715.26.
- **SECTION 4.** That violation of this Ordinance by either the homeowner or the insurance company shall be a first (1^{st}) degree misdemeanor.
- **SECTION 5.** The foregoing Ordinance was adopted and all actions and deliberations of the Village of Dennison, Tuscarawas County, Ohio relating thereto were conducted in open meetings to the public in compliance with all applicable legal requirements including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by Council and shall become effective upon passage by Council.
