

ORDINANCE NO. 2407

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING ON, DRIVING OVER OR DESTRUCTION OF THE CURBS IN THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Dennison has determined that it is necessary to prohibit the parking on, driving over or destruction of the curbs in the Village of Dennison;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON, STATE OF OHIO;

SECTION 1. No person shall park on any curb on any street, sidewalk, alley or other roadway in the Village of Dennison.

SECTION 2. No person shall drive over any curb on any street, sidewalk, alley or other roadway in the Village of Dennison.

SECTION 3. No person shall destroy, alter, damage, remove or deface any curb on any street, sidewalk, alley or other roadway in the Village of Dennison.

SECTION 4. Should any person wish to construct a driveway said person shall submit a written request to the Mayor's office. No work on said driveway shall begin until the request is approved.

SECTION 5. That violation of this Ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor on the first offense. A second violation of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor of the fourth (4th) degree. A third or more violation of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor of the third (3rd) degree.

SECTION 6. The foregoing Ordinance was adopted and all actions and deliberations of the Village of Dennison, Tuscarawas County, Ohio relating thereto were conducted in open meetings to the public in compliance with all applicable legal requirements including Sections 121.22 of Ohio Revised Code. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by Council and shall become effective upon passage by Council.
