

**ORDINANCE NO. 2529**

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING OF TRASH TRUCK ON  
VILLAGE STREETS OF THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON, OHIO,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Dennison, Ohio has reviewed issues involving parking of trash trucks along the streets and roadways located in the Village of Dennison, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Dennison, Ohio, after such review, has determined that there is currently a need to regulate the parking of trash trucks on the streets and roadways located in the Village of Dennison, Ohio;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. No person shall park or cause to be parked a trash truck on the streets and roadways located in the Village of Dennison, Ohio, except for the specific purpose of loading said trash truck. "Trash truck" is defined as any commercial vehicle utilized for the collection and dispose of garbage or refuse.

SECTION 2. A violation of this Ordinance is a minor misdemeanor. A person violating this Ordinance shall be assessed a fine of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00). Each period of twenty-four (24) hours that a trash truck remains parked in violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a separate violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Upon a violation of the within ordinance, the Police Department of the Village of Dennison, Ohio shall have the authority and discretion to cause the towing of an illegally parked trash truck, and the trash truck owner shall be solely responsible for the towing expense.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby deemed to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Dennison, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
